Who should do the course?

Supporting Adult Survivors of Childhood Abuse (SASCA) is a one-day training workshop aimed at anyone who works directly with adult survivors of childhood abuse or who manages staff who do or who commissions services.

The SASCA training will provide delegates with an understanding of the enduring impacts of childhood abuse in adulthood and how best to engage and

work with survivors in a way that is safe and effective for all involved.

What you will gain

- Deep understanding of how child abuse and neglect affects mental, physical, emotional and social health in adulthood
- Skills and confidence to effectively support a disclosure of abuse
- Knowledge and skills to recognise abuse-related stress reactions and prevent re-traumatisation
- Awareness of trauma-informed principles and how to apply them when working with adult survivors in any setting
- Awareness of the three-phase model of recovery
- Understanding and guarding against vicarious trauma
