NAPAC exists to support survivors of childhood abuse. The damage caused by abuse in childhood doesn't always end in childhood. Many adults with a history of childhood abuse can continue to suffer – from post-traumatic stress disorder, eating disorders, depression, and other issues. They can suffer from low self-esteem and be prone to self-harm or suicide. It doesn't have to be this way – this the chance for you to change someone's life for the better.

We are seeking an empathetic and resilient Volunteer Call and Email Handlers to join our friendly team in Stockport. Volunteer Call and Email Handlers answer calls to NAPAC's primary survivor support service – the telephone support line and our email support service. Along with staff they provide telephone support to adult survivors of childhood abuse and those supporting them. Overall, they will have a commitment to delivery of excellence in everything NAPAC does for survivors and their supporters.

Commitment: One four-hour shift a week.

Closing date for applications: 10:00am Thursday 13 January 2022.

Training dates: Weekly training for six weeks beginning 19 January 2022.

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis so those interested are encouraged to apply early as there are limited training places.
